## GUEST F.A.Q.'S

**What demographic listens to The EnneaCast?** On average, listeners range from their early 20s through late 50's. Listenership does not skew heavily by gender. Most listeners are Christians who lean conservative/moderate in their theology and trust that teaching on The EnneaCast will be biblically faithful, culturally informed and psychologically sensitive. Listeners are seeking wisdom, self-clarity and practical coaching to help improve their relationships with God, others and themselves by utilizing the enneagram from a Christian perspective.

**What is the time commitment?** Guests will want to block off at least 1 hour for their appearance on the show. Some guests opt to block off 1.5 hours but this is optional.

**What should guests expect?** Guests should anticipate a 25-35 minute interview related to the enneagram, their personality and Christian faith followed by a 10 minute game (in the style of Jimmy Fallon's games on *The Tonight Show* but related to personality) and a final 11 quick questions to wrap up the segment. Content will be edited for time.

**Can guests promote their latest work?** Yes! Bios are read aloud to introduce guests to listeners before their interview. These typically include clear overviews of each guest's latest projects. Likewise, during the closing credits all listeners are reminded how to connect with each guest's work. The EnneaCast does not conduct interviews centered around a guest's work unless it directly relates to the enneagram, relationship coaching or themes of a current series on the podcast. However, guests are highly encouraged to naturally weave in content from their latest project during the interview.

**Do I need to be an enneagram expert to be a guest?** Guests are not required to be experts in the enneagram but an entry-level understanding of the enneagram is essential. An entry-level understanding includes A. The guest knowing their core type, B. Being able to discuss their type with some degree of reflective insight and C. Being able to share personal stories from their life that illustrate their personality in action.

**Do I need to be a Christian to be a guest?** Generally, we only have fellow Christians on as guests. However, we do occasionally have guests that defy our norms. Some guests might not be Christian. Others may be from Christian traditions that are outside our own. Feel free to inquire about this more if you are concerned or have questions.
